Suvi Chair sündis tellimusena Agudose küla koolile São Paulo regioonis Brasiilias. Koolimaja ehitamisel kasutati vaid kohalikke materjale nagu muld, bambus ja puit ning meil paluti järgida sama põhimõtet. Protsess algas traditsiooniliste bambusmööbli tehnikate õppimisega. Sellele järgnes kohapeal ülesseatud töökojas bambusega eksperimenteerimine, et luua lihtne ja ladustatav bambustool. Istmena kasutasime külma ja tugevat hambapasta tuubidest valmistatud plaatmaterjali, mis sobis hästi troopilisse kliimasse ja täiendas visuaalselt väga "savist" koolimaja.

Olime kaasatud ka kogu tootmisprotsessi alates bambuse lõikusest kuni 80 tooli valmistamiseni.

Suvi Chair was commissioned by a school in Agudos, a village in the countryside of the state of São Paulo, Brazil. The school was built following the principle of only using local materials like rammed earth, wood and bamboo. We were asked to follow the same approach. The design process started by learning the traditional bamboo furniture techniques and was followed by experimenting with bamboo in a workshop we set up in situ. The aim was to come up with a simple and stackable bamboo chair. We used recycled toothpaste tube board for the seat of the chair. This is an ecological, strong and cold material, suitable for the tropical climate and visually complementing the very earthy building.

We were also involved in the whole production process from harvesting bamboo until the execution of 80 chairs.
