

We aspire to develop autonomous tooth brushing habit among 5 to 10-year-olds




The design process

The interviews with kids and their parents revealed two insights. First, kids know why oral health is essential, but the brushing action is boring, and secondly, the taste of toothpaste is amazing.

Over six months, we created two different game concepts, user-tested and fine-tuned them with the help of a kids behaviour psychologist, selected the best concept and developed the mobile app for Android and iOS.

Defeat Mouth Monsters

The gameplay has 32 levels — one Mouth Monster per level. Every creature has a different personality, voice and tip for teaching. The kids' mission is to collect in-game toothbrushes and wash the Tooth monsters away.





The Wisdom Tooth is your wise buddy on this journey. He encourages you and your companions and shares invaluable mouth hygiene wisdom.

























Toothbrushing used to be a daily struggle to get the kid to the bathroom. But now, our boy wakes us up with the phone in his hand,
